From A.M. Madsen to F. Chederov Sist July 1939 (artract)

Thank you for your letter of July 21st July on receipt of which I cabled you "please assit some cabled suggestions re programms", but I am writing you by the North Atlantic Air Service leaving to-morrow so this letter takes the place of the promised ceble.

Bouglas and I have gone over the sketch of the programme and I enclose herewith a re-draft showing a number of suggestions and indicating which of the papers will be printed.

In the first place we were agreed I think that Mr Bue Björner was to be president of the Conference although the chair at other sessions will be taken by other people Mr Björner should give his presidential address at the opening session at which he should preside.

but he might arrive in New York on the evening of the lat so that he could be a speaker wither at the banquet that evening or at the luncheon the following day.

The programs which you are issuing and by which you evidently hope to gain many enrolments should embody an appeal to attend the Conference and pay the sentencing fee of the list of printed papers and east for a subscription of the first papers and east for a subscription of the supply of them. But perhaps you would put that kind of appeal in a circular letter although it is not clear whether you intend to send a covering letter or merely printed matter of which you have sent us a proof.

Of those who have provided printed papers the following will be present: B. Björner, Craigie, Douglas, Mason, Lissher, Campbell and probably Farmer from Canada. Lange has said he will be present but as stated not on the day on which his paper (A Letter from Menry George) is mentioned on the programme.

As for the other papers, you will observe that we have built them into the programme by saying that they will be formally presented in behalf of the authors by colleagues who are present at the Conference.

Our idea has been rather to follow the practice adopted at the London Conference which is that the printed papers are for the most part not to be read but rather to be introduced briefly and for a the basis of discussion. Therefore we have made an appropriate starred note on the programme.

The Business Meeting of the International Union is not likely to last more than an hour and we have filled in that session with suggested subjects.

You say note our attempt to group the subjects under certain main headings, such as "Land Value Taxation in Fractice".

For the rest, there are a number of gaps and there are the sessions devoted to addresses (with how much time for discussion?) by Aeronsohn, Faironild, Streit, Bronson Cervan, Tucker and Hillman. But you may have others: What about Professor H. Gunnison Brown?

Two papers from Canada namely "The Effects of Lang Value Policie in Canada" by Farmer and on Eritish Columbia (the work of a pioneer) could be formally presented by a Canadian delegate. Hamilton will not be present but you will know whether Farmer is likely to come. On the other hand you could choose John Anderson of Montreal or one of the leaders who are coming from Toronto.

Meanwhile, the whole of the funds of the International Union, including membership subscriptions to itself, show a net surplus of about \$500 so that, unless there is a large sale of the Conference papers, the Union will be handisapped to meet the printing expense of about \$500.

The last word I had from Ashley Mitchell, Treasurer, before he sailed for denode on 26th July, was that opportunity should be taken

(1) Copy of my air mail letter to you dated July ast. (2) Pages from August "Land & Liberty" which refer to the

International Conference.

(3) Galley proof of the Programme as we had re-drefted it and as referred to in my letter of July Slat; but this was not used as you did not eable us as we requested.

In your letter of July Seth you say that the preliminary programme of which you enclosed the proof, was not satisfactory to your self. Since then, we have received the noture copies of your circular which is still more disappointing to us. I have since heard from mr law Björmer (to whom I sent a copy; who is profoundly distrubed and disappointed.

I must point out to you frankly and firmly that it has the following

faults: (1) It makes no mention of this being an International Conference, and a very valuable publicity feature has been lost - (our list of

enrolled members includes mames for 30 countries).

(R) It gives no indication that there will be 19 printed papers covering a wide range of subjects which have been prepared and printed at considerable expense for the special purpose of the conference and

as its essential discussion material.

(3) It overlooks the fact that or bue bigrour, the crusident of the International Union is seedially going to the United States and that he should have been given the place of honour as President of the Con-ference ad as waking the Presidential Address, which is many the printed papers. Instead, he has been relegated to a very back seat, travelling all across the Atlantic merely to respond to an address of welcome by some annumed representative of the city. He has no mention even at the banquet or at the luncheon.

(4) There is no statement of the Conference ree as 1. (5) There is no invitation to anyone to purchase at 11 the Conference papers (and incidentally become carolled members and adherents even if absent, which we have exhorted people to do in repeated announcements, and by circular, and with countderable success. (6) In one of your letters you indicated that the platform speakers
will sen have helf an hour but that speakers from the floor of the Conference will only have three minutes each. I cannot imagine that the floor of the Conference will tolerate such arrangements, which nullify its being a conference and turn it into a series of lectures.

In your letter of July 28th you do not give any indication of how you intend to handle the Conference papers. We are left with the impression that you are going to have them on sale in some obscure corner of the conference whereas the art of this thing is to try and sell them beforehend and here them in the hands of those attending at the earliest possible manent so that they may read them before the conference begins. The whole idea was that the papers are the agenda of the conference and would not be read but would be presented in a brief statement, leaving es much feeility as possible for their disquesion.
