Henry George, author of "Progress and Poverty", has influenced the economy of governments throughout the world by founding the single-tax movement and the theory that a single tax on land would meet all costs of government:

I, Frank L. Rizzo, Mayor of the City of Philadelphia, do hereby proclaim Saturday, September 2, 1978 as

HENRY GEORGE DAY

in Philadelphia, and urge all citizens to recognize the many contributions of this great American economist upon the 139th anniversary of his birth.
