We, too, were shocked to hear of the death of Anna George, though we were aware of the seriousness of her condition. Anna was warned of this as far back as December, 1945, but you knew Anna - she was just too ambitious to let up on her many interests and endeavors to take the precautions necessary to protect her health. A rest of six weeks at the Medical Center did her a world of good, but she was no sooner home again when she allowed the many demands made upon her to overtax her strength, and so she returned to the Medical Center - but this time did not recover. So the second generation of the Henry George family came to an end on March 17, 1947.

I am sorry you could not have attended the funeral services, which were most impressive.
