In short communism is the state ownership and control of all wealth producing and distributing agencies, controlled enterprise.

When our forefathers came to this country about I620 and after some experience with controlled enterprise tried to establish an "ANTIDO TE" to counteract the disease of control's and knowing there are only two forms of government, knew that free enterprise is the only "antidote" for controlled enterprise.

A-Yes, I believe the most important step is to know what effest state ownership and control of our wealth producing and distributing agencies has on our people? Mr. Noah Alper, said-we do nothing to prevent any one working. Self employment is not prohibited, but can five million unemployed, employ themselves? No. Production is controlled now, as it was three thousand years ago. Matthew 20-3, And he went about the third hour and saw others standing idle in the market place. 6 about the eleventh hour he went out and found others standing idle, and he said unto them, why stand ye here all the day idle? 7th They say unto him, because no man hath hired us. He said unto them, go ye into the vineyard; and whatsoever is right that shall ye receive

President Kennedy said-"we would like to see an America where every citizen is free to pursue those goals which his talent and capacities permit unhindered by artificial barriers of ignorance or prejudice. If the source of employment was not controlled, and the product of labor belonged to the producer, every one able and willing to work could produce the equivelant of wealth that he and his dependents consume.
