Dear Mr. Ince:

As a community service, the Henry George School of Social Science has developed a five day program of learning activities that may be of interest to your staff. This program can be employed to aid the development of learning skills. Understanding the learning process through logic and reasoning, critical thinking and listening (audio skills) are a sampling of the skills this program can be utilized for. This program may be applied to many English and Social Studies subjects in grades 9-12.

The activity is presented in the form of contest in which five teams attempt to answer questions, do research for a debate, make their presentation and defend their position. The teachers role is to explain the rules and guide the students through the exercise.

In order to encourage teachers unfamiliar with these exercises, The Henry George School of Social Science will provide professional instructors to aid and guide those who wish to familiarize themselves with these activities during the first and last sessions of the five day period. Furthermore, all materials necessary for the activity will be provided free of charge.

We will call you in several days for an appointment to explain the value of the program for your students.
