It appears that a certain Al Cunningham wants some of Alberta's "excess" 900 million put into "human capital" - the hospital workers.

What the C.U.PE. spokesman misses is the fact that oil and gas royalties in Alberta are the common property of all Albertans. Hospital workers do not have any title to "three or four months' interest on the \$900 million" which they say will meet their demands. They have a good title to an equal share in the rent (or royalty) from all the land in Alberta.
