I will soon have something very exciting to forward. My essay on "New Federalism" (the one we tried to evoke response to from the Wall Street Journal) is being published in a relatively new business periodical called The Greater Philadelphia Economist. I am hopeful the essay generates some reader response or inquiry, but we will to wait and see.

Some time ago, I began an outline for an idea I had on the use of a role play dialogue on economic issues to be used potentially in the first class. My hope is that this would both introduce the students to overriding issues and also generate some interest in the course as a participation rather than lecture approach.
