Dear Archivist:

In 1933(?) John Dewey delivered a radio address over WEVD in New York City that was subsequently published as a pamphlet by the Robert Schalkenbach Foundation. That address is to be included in a forthcoming volume in the Collected Works of John Dewey.

The pamphlet, one of the Pamphlets on the Economic Crisis of 1929 (Vol. 9, No. 9), was entitled Steps to Economic Recovery. The address was also published in Commerce and Finance, 30 August 1933, pp. 751-52, with the title "Plenty vs. Scarcity." Do you have any information in your records as to the date of the radio address, whether the pamphlet title was the radio address title, or the exact publication date of the pamphlet?

Also, is there any correspondence or related materials between Dewey and the Foundation in your records? The Center for Dewey Studies will gladly pay any searching, copying, and mailing costs incurred. Thank you for your assistance.
