NOW, THEREFORE, I, Thomas S. Gulotta, Nassau County Executive, do hereby proclaim Friday, March 22, 1991 as

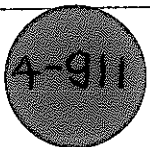

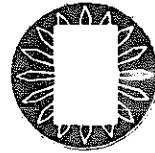

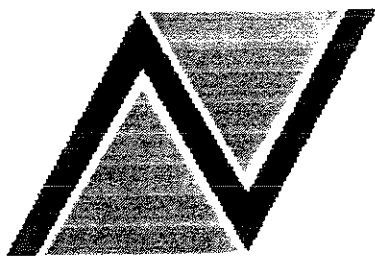
