To insure prosperity, remove the tax burden from farming, building, and all industry, and tax what's left — the unearned increment, the community-created value of natural resources, the only value created by the people as a whole, the true community pocketbook. The only ones opposed are those who plant by the moon and those who would steal the moon if it were not chained to the earth, the ignorant and the dishonest.

Pittsburgh and Scranton, Pa., by law enacted in 1913, tax buildings at half rate, and the 1951 legislature, by nearly unanimous vote, granted that right, greatly extended, to the 47 third-class cities. In California's great Central Valley, serving four million acres of land, 100 irrigation districts exempt improvements of every sort from taxation. The same principle is applied in many of the British Dominions.

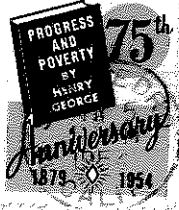
