

Conditions of Essay contest for prizes offered by the
Massachusetts Single Tax League and open to High School
students in Shrewsbury, Northborough and Southborough.

Subject of Essay - THE LAND VALUE TAX, an essential
to economic justice.

Prizes:- First - TEN DOLLARS:--- Second - FIVE DOLLARS,

Third - THREE DOLLARS in cash or in books as
the winner may choose.

Conditions:- All students wishing to compete must enter
their names with the High School principal on or before
February 4th and all essays must be handed in not later than
May 19th and must consist of not more than 1500 words. Lit-
erary skill as well as strength of argument will be con-
sidered in making the awards. Each essay is to be accompanied
by a card giving the name of the writer which shall not appear
on the essay. Each essay will be given a number and the card
numbered to correspond will be retained by the Superintendent
of Schools.

The judges shall be appointed by the
Massachusetts Single Tax League, and shall not be residents
of or connected with the Schools in the district and at
least one of them shall not be a known Single Taxer.

The essays shall become the property of
the Massachusetts Single Tax League and may be published.

The contestants will be given the privi-
lege of the library at the headquarters of the Massachusetts
Single Tax League, 120 Boylston St., and will be furnished
with a list of books bearing on the subject.
