A meeting of Ex Com. Mass Single Tax League was held ~~on~~ above date at office of Pres. Carret. Called to order 6.30 Vice Pres. Capon in Chair. Present Messrs Carret Capon Clark Pike Pierce Brazier. Fehrströhm Adams Johnson and Sterling. Minutes of previous meeting - read and approved. Circulars sent from Land Values Press Bureau of England referred to propaganda committee. Chairman Capon read the amended post card draft and letter from Mr Nichols. This matter was laid on table. Prof Johnson told of communication from Joseph Fels relative to being in Boston around Jan 3 to address Boston Chamber of Commerce and suggested a meeting with Single Tax League members. Discussion of letter followed and on motion a committee, consisting of Messrs Carret Johnson and Adams to be assisted by other members, was appointed to arrange for meeting and supper tendered to Mr. Fels. On motion of Mr Brazier Mr Joy was added to Ex Committee. The Secretary reported that on communications

received from Labor unions in reply to circular
