For the first time in fifteen years I am obliged to plead poverty. Single Tax has been my largest single tax and I have responded to appeals from Missouri, California, Fels, and Kiefer, and the Lord knows what all. There are too many single tax appeals. If there could be some unity and the money appropriated where it would do the most good I may perhaps be able to find \$10. a year, but the cost of living has doubled and my salary remains the same. I regret therefore, that I shall be obliged to ask you to consider me no longer a member of the Massachusetts Single Tax League.
