

NATIONAL SINGLE TAX LEAGUE OF THE UNITED STATES

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CINCINNATI, OHIO, Jan. 31, 1917

FRIEND OF THE SINGLE TAX CAUSE:

The Joseph Fels Fund Commission, which lapsed December 31st, has transferred its lists, equipment and good will to the new league. Mrs. Fels is a subscriber and a member of its Advisory Committee.

The new league is not yet democratically organized, but machinery has been provided, in a simple constitution, for making it so, as soon as the individual members shall elect their representatives and take possession.

This is an offer of membership in the new National Single Tax League, launched on January 4th by the Provisional Committee and about fifty advisers. Sign the enclosed membership card. Indicate on it the name of the man whom you wish to have represent you on the national committee. Two hundred votes (or proxies) will elect him. Each committeeman will vote the number of proxies thus assigned to him.

You will note that the membership is free, upon mere enrollment. If there be Single Taxers unable to help financially, their membership is desired none the less. Let the National League represent ALL of the Single Taxers of our country, giving in proportion to their means, if it be no more than a postage stamp. The largest subscribers to The Fels Fund and some 2000 lesser subscriptions have already given assurance of \$35,000 for the first year. The financial showing is gratifying, but the membership should be 20,000 rather than 2,000.

Fill out the enclosed membership card, including your vote for national committeeman, and your financial pledge if not previously given. If you have subscribed, your subscription, or an installment as agreed, is now due. If you have not subscribed, send the amount of your subscription with your membership card, thus saving the need of reminders.

The league is confronted with Single Tax opportunities in California, Colorado, Missouri, Oregon and elsewhere. Several aggressive publications merit its support. Big tasks of publicity, organization and education appeal for its help. When Single Tax shall have won its inevitable victory and be well on the road to universal adoption, it will be your proudest memory that you were a pioneer member in the great national agency that brought these things to pass. Act now.
