Dear Friend of the School:

Did you read the Star (page 3) on Friday, January 24? Or La Presse? Or Le Devoir? If you did, you already know that our ideas received some fine publicity in these newspapers. Our Alumni Group, the Canadian Research Committee on Taxation, appeared before the Belanger Royal Commission on Taxation in Quebec on Thursday the 23rd. Not only did the dailies report favorably on our submission, but so did the radio stations. We made certain that the majority of the stations in Montreal --both radio and television stations--got a copy of the brief with our press release.

Now, this is ACTION! Perhaps an educational campaign alone is not enough to propagate our ideas, but our Alumni Group uses methods that are far more effective in focussing public attention on George's remedy to our economic difficulties --also on the social philosophy attendant to it.

We are proceeding with an official incorporation of the Committee. We will soon have a federal charter as a non-profit research organization. This official status is another step in the right direction. We will become a nationally recognized organization and we are looking forward to greater progress and more growth because this is the only way we can hope to see the implementation of land value taxation. We cannot remain just 'that Montreal group' and, with the introduction of our Western Canada Division in 1963, we are now truly 'Canadian', nation-wide. While still working diligently at the local level, we must now get other groups of people in other parts of the country to press for our ideas.

You can lend a hand right now. We are including a copy of our submission to the Belanger Commission. Producing this brief cost us a sum of money which we very much need to carry on our work. May we suggest that you 'buy' this copy from us for at least, let us say, \$2 to \$5 ? Instead of a straight donation to the School, this is a case where you get something for your money beside the satisfaction of helping propagate the economic doctrine and social philosophy you believe in.
