Our Fighting Platform

1. Assessment of all rates on unimproved land values.

2. The Land Tax to be increased by another penny in the £ with no exemption for the additional penny; the revenue so raised to be applied to the reduction of railway freights and fares, and of Customs duties on the necessities of life not produced in New Zealand.

3. Those things which must be monopolised, if they are not socialised, shall be socialised for the common good of all, rather than be monopolised for the private advantage of the few.
