As you are doubtless aware our BADGE states our principles, Viz; "FREE LAND: FREE TRADE: FREE MEN." The surround states, "True Liberty Means Equal Liberty". The remedy is given as "Tax Land Values."

While the principle of obtaining Ground Rent or Land Rent for revenue is correct, the method, taxation is wrong expediently, wrong economically, wrong morally, and wrong from every point of view---including the interest of the rich.

When one is stuck or baffled with a problem, particularly when one is aware the principle is right, one has to go back to the roots and start afresh. Because we have refused to collect Ground Rent for St to Revenue, we have been obliged to use taxation as a means of raising revenue. In short, the strategy of collecting Annual Ground Rent is correct in every way, but the tactic of taxation is bad, false and misleading. Piling on more and more taxation only makes life for everyone worse and worse. Social upheaval and disaster for civilisation gets nearer and nearer every day.

To save the situation this Movement of ours has no option but to tell the world that a new birth is struggling to be born; it is, "GROUND RENT FOR STATE REVENUE."
