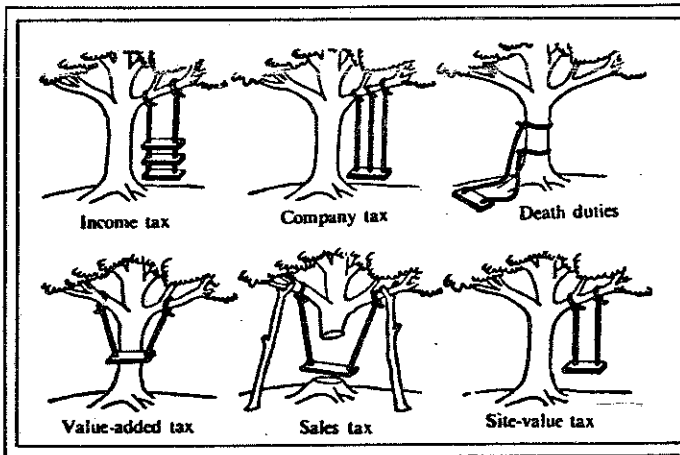

### Unemployed figures up

UNEMPLOYMENT among first degree architecture graduates rose by 50 per cent between 1979 and 1984, a new Government bulletin reveals.

A survey showed 48 graduates (3.9 per cent) to be jobless at December 31, 1984, compared with only 27 (2.6 per cent) in 1979. The details appear in the latest Department of Education & Science Statistical Bulletin 1/86.

### VAT's effects

THE decline in construction work after the imposition of VAT on alterations and extensions in 1984 has been highlighted in a report from the Federation of Master Builders.

The FMB State of Trade Survey concluded that although workloads improved during 1985 they remained well below 1983 levels.
